Greetings from the North,

February started with warm weather in Manitoba as we began our trip across the western provinces. It was quite unusual to have plus 3 degrees Celsius in Manitoba, plus 12 degrees Celsius in Saskatchewan, and a surprise blizzard in Alberta. The drive from our home church in Portage la Prairie, Manitoba, to Southern Alberta was wonderful until we arrived in Alberta. Nerves were on edge as my wife had to find the white line on the side of the road and call out directions while I drove 20 to 30 kilometres per hour. Our drive took longer than expected, and we were exhausted, but the Lord kept us safe.

We called on the Lord continually during the last half of the trip. We did pray to start our trip, but hitting that blizzard with a 25 foot trailer in tow was a new challenge. We pleaded for God's help endlessly. Our journey west had other challenges as winds in Saskatchewan blew over 70 kilometres per hour. This resulted in the driver's side trailer fender getting ripped off. I am not sure where it actually went as it was gone with the wind. We ended up having electrical issues with our truck that I could not figure out. The dear brothers in Alberta were of great help and took care of us. Our electrical issues differed from Southern to Northern Alberta, but Lord willing they are all resolved. We send special thanks to all the dear brethren who helped by giving advice and resolving these problems that I do not understand.

Our time in Alberta has been such a blessing! Watching Christians distribute God's Word in their communities is such an encouragement to us. We have been blessed to help assemble and distribute John and Romans in multiple locations, knock on doors, and minister in a Nursing Home this past month. God has been so gracious to allow us to work for Him.

Our mission director has requested that we inform you that Points North Baptist Mission, our missions agency, burnt to the ground on February 22, 2020. Please uphold Harvesters Baptist Church in your prayers as they lost many things in the fire. They will need to rebuild much of their facilities.

We have been privileged to visit 13 churches and 1 youth camp in February. Many have said they would be praying for us. Others have informed us that God spoke to them due to our ministry. What an honour to be used of God in this way. We have also had two more churches and some individuals who have made financial commitments. We are humbled and amazed at how God intervenes on behalf of believers who will call and trust upon Him. Our support has now risen to 13%. This is an encouragement to us. Praise the Lord!
