We are grateful for safety in travelling across the stormy mountain passes of British Columbia, through the blizzards in Alberta, and along the sketchy highways of northern Saskatchewan and Manitoba. Many thanks to the Christian brothers and sisters who have graciously helped us along our deputation travels this month. We arrived at many churches as strangers, and left as lifelong friends.
