It was wonderful to see the snow melt away a little over a week ago in our area. Feeling the warm spring sun and air has also increased the warmth in our community. Although we are still honouring the expectation of our leaders, it is wonderful to see people out, smiling, and to a degree, engaging. There is a spirit of optimism in the north, even though our area is still locked down and travel throughout the province is limited due to the Covid-19 situation.

The province opened up church services to 25 individuals, which enabled us to start regular services. The neighbours of our people who attend Snow Lake Baptist Church have shown some interest in 'this new family in town' and have been asking questions. It has provided our small congregation some opportunities to be a testimony.

We were able to advertise our online services on the local online bulletin board and found that people from the community are taking note. Learning online methods of ministry have been interesting, but challenging as our internet connectivity and access to technology is limited. By God's grace, we have been able to upload and minister through this method.

Looking back at the last several months, it is amazing what God has done. Where we had planned to be on the road, we are on our field working as the Lord would allow under strange circumstances. We have had the privilege of conducting 14 Adult services and 5 Children's Church services this past month (much of them online) and know many have viewed these. Our daughter is becoming even better versed in playing the piano and has now taken up the challenge of learning the organ.

We are looking for open doors right now to serve the Lord, but it is a challenge when the doors all seem shut due to the regulations. We want to express a special thanks to all of you who have continued to support us although you are facing your own hardships in these present circumstances.

Please pray for the ministry here as we look for opportunities to be a testimony within the community. We would like to use Father's Day to reach others but will need wisdom to plan an event wisely. Permanent housing for the family is also an item of prayer. A friend, Mr. Kirk, has been showing more openness, and we desire to be an effective witness. Please pray that he and others in the town will turn to Christ.

We are rejoicing at the many "handfuls of purpose" that the Lord has given to us. May we continue to look to our Blessed Hope and count the numerous blessings that He so generously supplies!
