Two cases of COVID were announced in the Town of Snow Lake a few days after the door hanger blitz. Many local residents became increasingly alarmed and fearful. They began to demand that tighter restrictions be put in place. We were disappointed as we had just distributed the invitations. Please pray for wisdom as we want to finish blitzing the surrounding area. We had two people who stated that they would come to church, but they did not show up. One lady was really amused and thought this was a novel way to introduce oneself to the town. We were encouraged and blessed to spread the Gospel in a positive manner.

The children had been learning the books of the Bible in Sunday School during the past few months. It was wonderful to hear the oldest class sing their way through the books of the Bible as a special song one Sunday morning.

We are adjusting to life in the North. At least 70 centimeters (27.6 inches) of snow fell within 10 days. We kept busy shovelling! The children also helped Mom and Dad haul 2 loads of wood between snowstorms. Our family is very thankful for a comfortable house and a warm woodstove.

We appreciate the many notes, prayers, and gifts that have been sent this past month. These mean more than words can express.
