DOCTRINAL STATEMENT

- ◆ The Holy Scriptures have absolute authority. God has taken the responsibility for His incorruptible Word and preserved the Scriptures. (Ps. 12:6-7) God's Word cannot pass away and is perfectly preserved in the Authorized (King James) Version.
- ◆ One eternal God exists as God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. Each is equal in power and glory but have distinct offices. (Matt. 3:15-17)
- ◆ God created all things in six literal days and is the sustainer of all things visible and invisible. He holds all things together by the Word of His power. (Gen. 1)
- ◆ Jesus Christ is God manifest in the flesh, virgin born, sinless, crucified, and risen. He is coming again to receive His church and then returning to earth to establish His Kingdom. (1 Tim. 3:16)
- ◆ Salvation is a free gift of God available to all men. It is by grace through faith in the finished work of Jesus Christ. It is not of human works or merits of any kind. (Eph. 2:8-9)
- ◆ Saved individuals are eternally secure. They are sealed in Christ. These children of God are taught and comforted by the Holy Spirit until Glory, where they will be with God in Heaven forever. (Eph. 1:12-13; John 10:28-29)
- ◆ Believers are to follow Christ Jesus in water baptism by immersion. It is a public testimony of Christ's finished work in believers and has no part in saving them. (Acts 8:35-39)
- ◆ Believers have a responsibility to assemble together in a church and to give financially to the ministries of the church. They need to continue in personal and family devotions with the Lord. Believers are to be active in spreading the gospel to a dying world. (Heb. 10:25; Matt. 28:19)
- ◆ Those who reject Jesus Christ will be condemned in their sin to an eternity in the Lake of Fire. (Rev. 21:8)
- ◆ Believers should conform to God's leading from His Word. They should not conform to this world. Believers should obey because of the inward change that occurs in the heart and not because of law and command. Weight should be placed on the inward condition, understanding that the outward appearance will follow accordingly. (Rom. 12:1-2)
